The club was formed in 1981 by a group of enthusiasts for those people who are interested in scale and stand-off scale models of launches, boats, ships and sailing vessels. Models presently encompassed by the society, range from the simplest kitset available to sophisticated radio-controlled models which have taken years to complete.

Club Activities

- Monthly Meetings
These usually include at least one organised demonstration depicting some aspect of the hobby and videos are shown when they are available. Members are encouraged to bring along their models to these meetings, completed or uncompleted, for members to see and discuss any ideas or to offer advice on problems. Society meetings are held on the second Wednesday of each month at 19.30 hours (7.30 p.m.), the venue is the S.M.M. clubhouse on the Petersons Reserve, off Waipuna Road, Mount Wellington.
- Public Sailing
As part of membership, members are required to assist with the running of the club boats which is the club's major source of funds. Each member is required to assist at least twice per year by means of a roster. Assisting with the public boats enables the club to keep membership fees down. Public sailing usually starts at 1pm and ends at 4pm on the relevant Sunday afternoons. Club boats are available for the public to use for a small donation.
- Club Sailing
Sailing takes place on our club pool, which is adjacent to the A.S.M.E. railway complex at Petersons Reserve. Sailing usually commences at 10.00 hours (10.00 a.m.) until approximately 15.30 hours (3.30 p.m.). Members are, of course, able to sail on the club pool whenever they wish, and the club pool is in use every Sunday as follows:
 - 1st, 2nd, 4th and 5th Sundays of the month:
 - Free sailing from approximately 10.00 hours (10.00 a.m.)
 - Public sailing from 1pm if the public boats are running.
 - 3rd sunday of the month:
 - Reserved for club competitions. Competition usually starts at 10am with a different course each month. Points scored count towards the yearly competitions. Events cover mercantile steering, tug towing, yachting.
- Club boats available for the public to use for a small donation from 13.00 hours (1.00 p.m.) to 16.00 hours (4.00 p.m.). On public sailing days members can also sail provided their frequencies do not clash with those of the club boats.
- Public Displays
These are organised for such events as hobby exhibitions, boat shows, school galas etc.
All members are invited to display their models and their support is requested to assist in the organization and running of these events.
- Static Competitions
Usually held in the clubhouse on the November club night.
- The MailShip
A monthly magazine is sent to all society members. Club news, model building information, members articles etc. All contribute to the MailShip.
- Library
The society runs a library for members which contains books on all aspects of shipping and modelling. We also have a plan library which covers most types of vessels. The library is widely used by members and is growing all the time.
- Workshops
On club nights, from time to time. Members requiring help or advice can bring their models along on normal club nights for this purpose.
- Membership
Full membership covers all members of the family. When children reach 14 years, they are expected to become a junior member. Junior membership & associated membership gives members the monthly MailShip only.

One of the society's aims is to foster family participation in all club activities. We have seating around the pool and a grassed area where members can sit and watch the proceedings. There is also a covered area to keep members and their boats reasonably dry in inclement weather. From time-to-time barbeques may be organized in conjunction with special competitions. Twilight sailing is available if requested by members.

I hangaia te karapu i te tau 1981 e te roopu kaingākau mo te hunga e pirangi ana ki nga tauira tauine me nga tauira tauine o te whakarewanga, poti, kaipuke me nga waka tere. Ko nga tauira e noho ana i tenei wa e te hapori, mai i te kete ngawari e waatea ana ki nga tauira maatai i te reo irirangi kua maha nga tau ki te whakaoti.

Nga Mahi Karapu

- Hui Marama

Kei roto i enei ko te kotahi neke atu ranei nga whakaaturanga kua whakaritea e whakaatu ana i etahi ahuatanga o te whakangahau me nga ataata ka whakaatuhia ina watea ana. Ka akiakihiha nga mema ki te kawe mai i a ratou tauira ki enei hui, kua oti, kua oti ranei, kia kite nga mema me te korerorero mo nga whakaaro, ki te tuku tohutohu ranei mo nga raruraru. Ka tu nga hui a te hapori i te rua o nga Wenerei o ia marama i te 19.30 haora (7.30 p.m.), ko te waahi ko te S.M.M. whare karapu i te Rahui Petersons, i waho o te huarahi o Waipuna, Maunga Poneke.

- Te Whakatere i te iwi

Hei waahanga mema, me awhina nga mema ki te whakahaeere i nga poti karapu ko te tino puna moni a te karapu. Me awhina ia mema kia rua neke atu i ia tau ma te rarangi rarangi. Ma te awhina i nga poti a-iwi ka taea e te karapu te pupuri i nga utu mema. Ko te tikanga ka timata te whakatere waka a te iwi i te 1pm ka mutu hei te 4pm i nga ahiahi o te Ratapu. E waatea ana nga poti karapu hei whakamahi ma te marea mo te koha iti.

- Whakatere Karapu

Ka rere te waka ki runga i to matou puna karapu, e tata ana ki te A.S.M.E. whare reriwe i Petersons Reserve. Ko te tikanga ka timata te whakatere i te 10.00 haora (10.00 a.m.) tae noa ki te 15.30 haora (3.30 p.m.). Ko te tikanga, ka taea e nga mema te rere i runga i te puna kaukau karapu i nga wa katoa e hiahia ana ratou, a kei te whakamahia te puna karapu i ia Ratapu penei:

- 1, 2, 4 me te 5. Ratapu o te marama:

- o Rere kore utu mai i te tata ki te 10.00 haora (10.00 a.m.)
- o Ka rere te iwi mai i te 1pm mena kei te rere nga poti a te iwi.

- Ratapu tuatoru o te marama:

o Rahui mo nga whakataetae karapu. Ko te tikanga ka timata te whakataetae i te 10am me tetahi akoranga rereke ia marama. Ko nga piro kua tohua ki nga whakataetae o ia tau. Ko nga huihuinga e kapi ana i te urungi hokohoko, te kukume waka, te waka waka. Ko nga poti karapu e waatea ana ma te marea hei whakamahi mo tetahi koha iti mai i te 13.00 haora (1.00 i te ahiahi) ki te 16.00 i nga haora (4.00 i te ahiahi). I nga ra e rere ana te iwi ka taea ano e nga mema te rere mena karekau e taupatupatu ana nga reiti ki era o nga poti karapu.

- Whakaaturanga mo te iwi

Ka whakaritea enei mo nga huihuinga penei i nga whakaaturanga whakangahau, whakaaturanga poti, huihuinga kura aha atu. Ka tonohia nga mema katoa ki te whakaatu i o raatau tauira, ka tonohia to raatau tautoko ki te awhina i te whakahaeere me te whakahaeere i enei huihuinga.

- Whakataetae Panuku

I te nuinga o te wa ka tu ki te whare karapu i te po karapu o Noema.

- Te MailShip

Ka tukuna he maheni ia marama ki nga mema hapori katoa. Nga korero a te karapu, nga korero hanga tauira, nga tuhinga mema me etahi atu. Ka uru katoa ki te MailShip.

- Whare Pukapuka

Ka whakahaerehia e te hapori he whare pukapuka mo nga mema kei roto nga pukapuka mo nga ahuatanga katoa o te kaipuke me te whakatauira. He whare pukapuka mahere ano ta matou e kapi ana i te nuinga o nga momo waka. Kei te whakamahia nuitia te whare pukapuka e nga mema, a kei te tipu haere i nga wa katoa.

- Awheawhe

I nga po karapu, ia wa ki tera wa. Ka taea e nga mema e tono awhina, tohutohu ranei te kawe mai i a raatau tauira i nga po karapu mo tenei kaupapa.

- Mema

Ka kapi katoa te mema katoa o te whanau. Ka eke nga tamariki ki te 14 tau, ko te whakapae ka noho hei mema teina. Ko te mema teina me te mema hono ka whakawhiwhia ki nga mema te MailShip ia marama anake.

Ko tetahi o nga whainga a te hapori ko te whakatairanga i te whai waahi a te whanau ki nga mahi katoa a te karapu. He nohoanga matou huri noa i te poka wai me tetahi waahi tarutaru e noho ai nga mema ki te matakitaki i nga mahi. He waahi hipoki ano kia noho maroke nga mema me o ratou poti i te kino o te rangi. Mai i ia wa, ka taea te whakarite i nga rorerore me nga whakataetae motuhake. Kei te waatea te rerenga o te ahiahi mena ka tono mai nga mema.
